GOLDEN RECORDS - WHERE TO START?

As a member of the club you can now store and keep track of your archery performance on Golden Records. You can track personal bests, current handicaps and current classifications. Your handicaps and classifications will automatically be updated. You will also be able to track club records and be notified when club records are broken.

To avoid any confusion, this is not an App for scoring which many of you already use. You need to score as usual and then log totals online in Golden Records.

Log in and go to ≡ in the top right hand corner. This should give you a drop down menu with an option of ADD MY SCORE. The rest is fairly self-explanatory, but if you get stuck, please ask and we will be happy to assist.
